

TITLE 8 - PROPERTY

CHAPTER 8-4 CONFORMITY WITH DESIGNATED BUILDING CODES

8-4-1 Background and Intent

On August 16, 2006, Tribal Council amended this Chapter by providing for the following designated building codes to be applicable only to the Three Rivers Casino Gaming Facility (Facility). These designated building codes shall be applicable until such time as the Tribes enact tribal ordinances at least as strict as these corresponding codes.

8-4-2 to 8-4-11 Reserved for Expansion

8-4-12 All structures shall be built consistent with the most recent editions of the International Building Code (IBC).

8-4-13 For purposes of fire and life safety issues, all structures shall be built consistent with the most current Oregon version of the Uniform Fire Code.

8-4-14 Any drinking water system constructed for purposes of supplying the Facility with drinking water shall be constructed in compliance with the standards established in the Oregon Administrative Rules 333-061-0050 through 333-061-0055

The Tribal Council of the Confederated Tribes of Coos, Lower Umpqua and Siuslaw Indians approved and enacted the amended “Conformity with International Building Codes” Ordinance, Resolution No. 06-104, Ordinance No. 054A, at a special Tribal Council meeting on August 16, 2006. Vote was 4 (for), 0 (against), and 0 (abstaining). With this resolution, the title will be changed to “Conformity with Designated Building Codes”.

The Tribal Council of the Confederated Tribes of Coos, Lower Umpqua and Siuslaw Indians approved and enacted the Conformity with International Building Codes Ordinance, Resolution No. 04-007, Ordinance No. 054, at a regular Council Meeting on January 11, 2004. Vote was 5 (for), 0 (against), and 0 (abstaining).
