APPEAL -- SUMMARY DISPOSITION

25-234 BD. OF ELECTION COMM'RS, ET AL. V. NAACP, ET AL.

The judgment is vacated, and the case is remanded to the United States District Court for the Southern District of Mississippi for further consideration in light of *Louisiana v. Callais*, 608 U. S. ____ (2026). Justice Jackson, dissenting: This case presents only the question of Section 2's private enforceability, which our decision in *Louisiana v. Callais*, 608 U. S. ____ (2026), did not address. Thus I see no basis for vacating the lower court's judgment. Instead, in light of *Morse v. Republican Party of Va.*, 517 U. S. 186 (1996), I would summarily affirm.
