MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF STATE OF HAWAII'S MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER, AND AN ORDER TO QUASH SUBPOENA DUCES TECUM

Plaintiff Pele Defense Fund has issued two separate subpoena duces tecum for oral depositions and production of documents to Maurice Kaya and Dr. Fred D. Stone. Mr. Kaya is the Energy Program Administrator for the Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism; Dr. Fred Stone has worked under contract for the Department of Land and Natural Resources preparing a burial lava tube study of certain lands in the Puna area. The burial lava tube study is a public

document and Plaintiffs have or can easily obtain a copy of the document; however, disclosure of the actual locations of the lava tube is protected to prevent scavengers from raiding the sites. A copy of each subpoena duces tecum is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibits "1" and "2".

The subpoena addressed to Mr. Kaya commands him to "bring with him any and all documents relating to current State of Hawaii geothermal development plans and/or policies on the Island of Hawaii or other islands." The subpoena duces tecum issued to Dr. Stone commands him to bring "any and all documents relating to archaeological activities in the former Puna forest reserve and adjoining lands, conducted pursuant to contracts with either the State of Hawaii, the Campbell Estate, or True Energy Geothermal Corp. and/or Mid-Pacific Geothermal, Inc."

The State objects to the oral deposition notice and subpoena for document production issued to Mr. Kaya on the basis that the matters sought appear clearly to exceed the scope and relevance of the issues on remand in this case. The State objects to the deposition notice and subpoena to produce records issued to Dr. Stone to the extent Plaintiff seeks to inquire into activities and findings outside the boundaries of the Campbell Estate lands at issue in the lawsuit and to disclosure of the location of the burial lava tube which would expose it to desecration by scavengers.

BACKGROUND

The Pele Defense Fund filed this lawsuit against the State Board of Land and Natural Resources, Campbell Estate, True Energy Geothermal Corporation and its predecessors, challenging the land exchange which occurred between the State and Campbell Estate in 1985. This case was appealed to the State Supreme Court which upheld the land exchange and found against Plaintiff on all claims, with the exception of an alleged violation of Article XII, Section 7 of the Hawaii State Constitution, commonly known as kalipi rights. See Pele Defense Fund v. Paty, 73 Haw. 587 (1992). The State Board of Land and Natural Resources was dismissed as a party from the lawsuit and the Judgment on Appeal remands the case for further hearings on the claim alleging that Campbell Estate and True Geothermal violated Plaintiff's kalipi rights by "the continued denial of access to the undeveloped areas of Wao Kele 'O Puna and other exchanged lands." See Exhibit "3" attached hereto and incorporated herein. The scope of kalipi rights and the determination of who is entitled to exercise those rights can be gleamed from the decisions of Kalipi v. Hawaiian Trust, Ltd., 66 Haw. 1 (1982); Pele Defense Fund v. Paty, id., and Public Access Shoreline Hawaii v. Hawaii County Planning Commission, 1993 Westlaw 15605 (this Hawaii Appellate Court opinion has not been released for publication. Presumably either a petition for reconsideration or a petition for certiorari are pending.)

The issue on remand does not involve the use or access to the State lands, nor does it involve the State's geothermal plans, policies, or activities on either the Big Island or elsewhere in the State. The issue of the present denial of access is not impacted by the future policy of the State relative to geothermal development. Such development and the location of it is purely a matter of speculation. Future development, if it occurs, is not relevant to past or present denial of access to undeveloped lands.

Clearly, the Plaintiff's motivation is to expand the scope of their inquiry to gather information for use in other pending, or planned, lawsuits. Pele Defense Fund, or its individual members, are not strangers to geothermal litigation, and over the past ten years have engaged in multiple lawsuits. See Dedman v. DLNR, 69 Haw. 255 (1987); Medeiros v. Hawaii County Planning Commission, 8 Haw. App. 183 (1990); Pele Defense Fund v. Puna Geothermal Venture, Inc., 8 Haw. App. 203 (1990); Pele Defense Fund v. Puna Geothermal Venture, 9 Haw. App. 143 (1992); <u>Ualelo v. Paty</u>, 902 F.2d 1395; <u>Pele Defense</u> Fund v. Paty, 73 Haw. 578 (1992). Thus, the State requests that the Court issue a protective order prohibiting Plaintiff from taking the oral deposition of Maurice Kaya and quashing the subpoena duces tecum, and further, issue a protective order prohibiting the oral deposition and document production from Dr. Stone to the extent inquiry is made concerning matters outside the land owned by Campbell Estate and to the exact

location of the burial lava tubes on the grounds that these matters are irrelevant to the issues involved in this lawsuit.

There are no claims remaining against Defendants-Appellees WILLIAM PATY, MOSES KEALOHA, DOUGLAS ING, LEONARD ZALOPANY, JOHN ARISUMI, and HERBERT ARATA, and they are accordingly dismissed from the action.

- 2. Attached to the Motion for Protective Order are true and correct copies of the subpoena duces tecum which were served on Maurice Kaya and Dr. Fred Stone.
- 3. The State requests that the Court issue a protective order to prohibit the deposition of Maurice Kaya and quash the subpoena duces tecum issued to Mr. Kaya on the grounds that the matters sought in the subpoena clearly fall outside the scope of whether Campbell Estate has denied access to its lands for the purpose of exercising Plaintiff's kalipi rights.
- 4. The State objects to the oral deposition and subpoena duces tecum issued to Dr. Stone on the basis that Plaintiff seeks information concerning lands outside those owned by Campbell Estate, and they seek documents identifying the precise location of the burial lava tube which must remain confidential to prevent desecration of the burial sites.
