WHEREAS, the Bad River Tribal Council, acting in conformity with Article II - Membership, Section II, of the Bad River Tribal Constitution, and Article VII - Final Adjustment of Rolls, Section I, of the Tribal Membership Ordinance, as amended, and,


WHEREAS, Article VII - Section I of the Tribal Membership Ordinance stipulates that the membership roll as prepared and compiled by the Tribal Membership Committee, must be approved by the Bad River Tribal Council before submission to the Superintendent of the B.I.A. at the Great Lakes Agency and to the Area Director, and,

NOW BE IT RESOLVED, that the Bad River Tribal Council hereby approves the Membership Roll as prepared, compiled and submitted by the Bad River Tribal Membership Committee, consisting of sixty (60) pages containing the names of 2398 confirmed tribal members, as stipulated in the Tribal Membership Ordinance, and,


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the approved Membership Roll shall not be disturbed in whole or in part, without the approval of the Secretary of the Interior.

WHEREAS, it is essential that the Bad River Band of Lake Superior Chippewa, to identify its members in accordance with Article II - Membership of the Tribe's Constitution, and to insure that the names of its members are preserved for all time, shall hereby establish a Tribal Membership Roll in accordance with Article II - Membership of the Tribe's Constitution, and,

WHEREAS, the establishment of the Tribal Membership Roll shall be charged to the Tribal Membership Committee appointed by the Tribal Council, independent of the Council's own members, and,

WHEREAS, to insure that the Tribal Membership Committee establishes and maintains the Tribal Membership Roll in accordance with Article II - Membership of the Tribal Constitution, the Membership Committee shall be given direction and force by the proposed Tribal Membership Ordinance and By-Laws, and now be it,


RESOLVED, that the proposed Tribal Membership Ordinance and By-Laws of the Bad River Membership Committee be hereby adopted and attached to the Tribe's Constitution.




