RESOLUTION NO. 11-5-80-131

WHEREAS .

The Bad River Tribal Council makes the following findings:

- (1) That the Bad River Tribal Court Code establishes a civil remedial forfeiture procedure,
- (2) That the Code leaves ambiguous whether a defendant in a civil forfeiture action has a right to expect a trial on the return date of the citation,
- (3) That it is in the best interests of the Court and those who appear before it to anticipate the proceedings that will occur on the return date of a citation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the ordinance appended hereto, specifying the proceedings to occur on the return date of a citation, be enacted into law.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRIBAL COURT CODE, RESOLUTION 9-5-79-8, TO CREATE CERTAIN CALENDARING PROVISIONS.

ARTICLE XXIII, Section 7.5, is hereby created to read:

Section 7.5. Upon the return of the citation, the defendant shall enter a plea. If the defendant denies the allegations of the complaint a date for trial shall be set.
