- WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Community is a Federally recognized Indian Tribe with a Constitution and By-Laws approved November 18, 1937; and
- WHEREAS, There has been an increased concern and awareness of gang activity within and around the Stockbridge-Munsee Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, The Menominee Nation recently passed an ordinance regulating Curfew and Hitchhiking for juveniles on the Menominee Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council has the duty and responsibility to protect the health and welfare of its tribal members; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council hereby approves and enacts the attached ordinance entitled, "Juvenile Delinquency: Curfew and Hitchhiking."
