WHEREAS, the Stockbridge-Munsee Community Band of Mohican Indians is a federally recognized Indian tribe governed by the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council, pursuant to authority vested in the council by a Constitution approved on November 1937, and

WHEREAS, the Stockbridge-Munsee Community has the authority under it's Constitution and it's inherent rights as a sovereign nation to pass ordinances regulating boundaries of the reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Stockbridge-Munsee Community enacted the Stockbridge-Munsee Liquor Ordinance, located at Chapter 31 of the Stockbridge-Munsee Ordinances, on February 12, 1992, and

WHEREAS, after observing the way the ordinance works and considering those observations, the Tribal Council has concluded that section 31, 1(E)4 of such ordinances be stricken to allow the ability to provide complimentary beverages, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council hereby passes the attached revised amended Stockbridge-Munsee Community Liquor Ordinance. Language stricken out is hereby eliminated from the ordinance.
