- WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Community, Band of Mohican Indians, is a federally recognized Indian tribe governed by the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council pursuant to authority vested in the Council by a Constitution approved in November 1937; and,
- WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Community has the authority under its constitution and its inherent rights as a sovereign nation to pass ordinances and amend ordinances; and,
- WHEREAS, Presently, the Change of Name Ordinance does not have a time requirement for meaningful notice by publication; and,
- WHEREAS, The following amendment provides more meaningful notice to others that may have an interest in the proposed change of name,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council amends the Change of Name Ordinance § 60.4 by adding the following sentence at the end of the §60.4: "Notice in the Mohican News and Shawano Leader shall not be less than 14 days and not greater than 90 days prior to the scheduled court hearing date, unless the Tribal Court finds good cause to waive this requirement."
