- WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Community, Band of Mohican Indians, is a federally recognized Indian tribe with inherent sovereign powers, and is governed by the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council pursuant to the 1937 Constitution;
- WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Community has the authority under its Constitution and its inherent rights as a sovereign nation to adopt and amend Ordinances;
- WHEREAS, Chapter 21, the Fish and Wildlife Ordinance, was adopted in 1978 and has since be amended, including a whole-scale changes that resulted in a repeal and adoption of a whole new ordinance in May 2008; and
- WHEREAS, Additional revisions have been identified to clarify the ordinance as well as to require hunter's safety for youth hunters and to limit the shining of wildlife.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council hereby adopts the following amendments to Chapter 21, which include the following changes:

- Amending Sections 21.8(C), 21.15.5(C)(1) and 21.15.5(G); and
- Creating new Sections 21.3(Q), 21.8(A)(1), 21.8(G) and 21.20(FF).
