- WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Community is a federally recognized Indian tribe with inherent sovereign powers and is governed by the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council pursuant to the 1937 Constitution, as amended;
- WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Community has the authority under its Constitution and its inherent rights as a sovereign nation to adopt and amend Ordinances;
- WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Community established a tribal court system under Chapter 1, Tribal Court Code, of tribal law;
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Council wishes to establish one ordinance that addresses civil procedure for practice before the court, as well as administrative procedures;
- WHEREAS, The present Chapter 5, Administrative Appeals, is currently focused on administrative procedures, and the Council wishes to repeal and replace this ordinance with a more inclusive civil procedure ordinance that incorporates procedures had previously been addressed in Chapter 1, the Tribal Court Code, and that adds new procedures as well as addressing administrative procedures.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Stockbridge-Munsee Tubal Council hereby repeals Chapter 5, the Administrative Appeals Ordinance, and adopts a new Chapter 5, Civil Procedures Ordinance.
