## RESOLUTION NUMBER TMBC1147-08-20 OF THE DULY ELECTED AND CERTIFIED GOVERNING BODY OF THE TURTLE MOUNTAIN BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS

- WHEREAS, the Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa Indians, hereinafter referred to as the Tribe, is an unincorporated Band acting under a revised Constitution and By-Laws approved by the Secretary of the Interior on June 16th, 1959 and amendments thereto approved; and
- WHEREAS, Article IX (a) Section 1 of the Turtle Mountain Constitution and By-Laws empowers the Tribal Council with the authority to represent the Band and to negotiate with Federal, State, and Local Governments and with private persons; and
- WHEREAS, Article VII Section 1 of the Turtle Mountain Constitution and Bylaws requires a 30-day comment period prior to the adoption of any ordinances or amendments to the Tribal Code, whether proposed by resolution or otherwise. Adoption must occur through a roll call vote of the Tribal Council at a publicly held meeting; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe is proposing to add to the Tribal Code, a Civil Commitment Code, with the purpose being to: (1) Protect, enhance and exercise the inherent sovereignty of the Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa Indians, (2) Create and define the policies and procedures governing the civil commitment of those that are subject to the Band's jurisdiction, (3) Provide prompt evaluation and treatment of persons with serious mental disorders or chemical dependency; and placed the proposed addition of the Civil Commitment Code to the Tribal Code out for public comment, with no comments received; now
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribe is adopting the addition of the Civil Commitment Code as Title 53 to the Turtle Mountain Tribal Code and will be numbered and codified accordingly, in its entirety.

## CERTIFICATION
